Background

These cases may involve a multitude of plaintiffs, class actions, or arbitrations, and tight eDiscovery and document management review and production deadlines.

Employment cases can also include complex, document-critical matters involving alleged misappropriation of trade secrets, suits to enforce non-competition agreements, wrongful discharge claims, and related matters. Privilege and confidential document protection can be critical. These cases can be very document and fact intensive and litigation support tools must support a high degree of accuracy.
